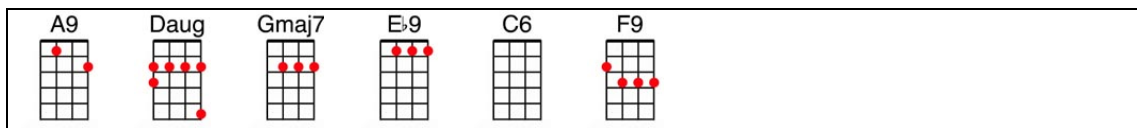

Notes. The **Gmaj7** chord is written above the lyrics as **GM7** (Gm7 is G minor 7)

You may prefer the alternate shape of **Daug** as **3221**

Finishes on **G**. (Slide barre from 6th to 7th fret)
